Prostate cancer has many faces. Over 220,000 American men are diagnosed with prostate cancer each year making prostate cancer the most common male cancer risk, except skin cancer. A man dies every 17 minutes in the U.S. from prostate cancer. Many men in their 40's and 50's are being impacted by this disease. Prevention is even better.

The Greater Chicago Prostate Cancer Run, Walk'n Roll is a joint venture between two well established not-for-profit organizations, UsTOO and Wellness Place. Both organizations support cancer survivors and their families in the northwest Chicago suburban area. All services are free of charge

UsTOO is an international, grassroots organization created by prostate cancer survivors. Local chapter meetings create support for survivors, families and caregivers to learn about treatment options, discuss post-treatment issues and shared experiences.
